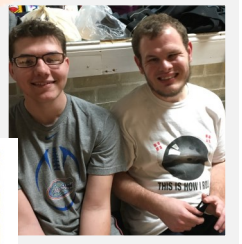

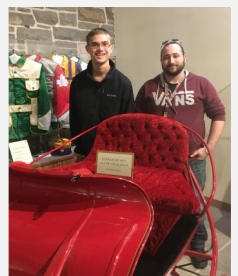
Without Walls Day Habilitation



What is a Without Walls Program

Rather than offering activities at one site, the “without walls” concept takes the individuals with disabilities into the community to develop life skills.

- Provides purpose on a daily basis
- Fulfills dreams
- Provides an outlet
- Provides rewarding experiences
- Builds self-esteem
- Provides meaningful connections
- Encourages independence
- Builds a skill-base, getting participants ready for jobs
- Develops participants into full members of society

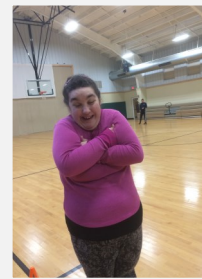


Why are we unique

- This program provides participants with person-centered activities.
- Individuals participate in 60% community assisting activities and 40% recreational activities.
- There is a small staff to individual ratio.
- This program increases socialization through peer interaction.

Who we support

Without Walls Day Habilitation serves individuals with disabilities, age 18+, who are no longer enrolled in the school system and OPWDD eligible.
